DARSC expands operations

The DAR Student Council has recently expanded its many operations while reporting successes in many fields, including website views and snack sales. Two weeks ago, reports from the Council Treasury indicated that Council funds were nearing \$200.

Meanwhile, the DARSC Vice President 1 - who also manages publication and outreach efforts - found many positive statistics and indicators in regards to school website views. "The overwhelming majority of students in Ms. Samia's class are now relying on the website for their homework assignments," he said, referring to the Council-sponsored daralrahman.org. "Now, we're going to try to encourage Ms. Reema's class to follow their lead."

His attitude was vaguely optimistic as he examined an increase in website views. In March, he said, the website netted 278 views. In April, the number was 301 - a number which, according to the Vice President, is relatively high when "other factors" are taken into account.

"In March, most of those visits came from a limited few. Towards the end of April, it became clear that a larger variety of viewers were using the website.

On Saturday, May 5, the Student Council is to launch a large advertising campaign aimed at gaining more website views from Ms. Reema's class. Meanwhile, website advertisement will continue to occur elsewhere in the school albeit on a smaller scale.
